Submit a brief essay outlining the relevance of your fieldwork research to the mission of the Abakanowicz Arts and Cultural Charitable Foundation (see Selection Criteria). 3. Agree to submit a short report at the end of the fellowship period (Feb. 15, 2021). 4. - Delineation of budget items needed (i.e., art supplies, transportation, need for personal financial support, etc.).
- Proposed timeline (please note that fieldwork this year can continue to be conducted in the fall if necessary due to Covid-19).
